ATTENTION TRAIL ENTHUSIASTS

The Village of Saranac recently purchased property at 113 N Bridge Street (west side of Bridge Street, north side of the new rail trail), with grant assistance from the Michigan Natural Resources Trust Fund. As you may have noticed, we immediately removed the dilapidated pole building from the property, but kept the cement pad in place. We did this with the intent of designating the area as parking for trail users, until such time that we begin developing the property. Please help us spread the word that this is the primary area for trail users to park. Parking is allowed at the depot lot, but should be used as a secondary option. The reason being, the depot has scheduled events and has found that there is not enough parking for event goers, due to trail users parking in the lot.

You may be wondering what our intent is for developing this property. Our goal is to build a trailhead, similar to what other communities are doing, hopefully with the assistance of another MNRTF grant. We are not sure what components will be included in the initial build, but at the very least we expect to have restrooms and some type of a shelter.
