WASTE COLLECTION SERVICES

We are happy to service the Village of Saranac. Please review the following information about your collection services.

SERVICE INFORMATION

To change or add services, contact the Village of Saranac office at 616-642-6324.

SERVICES AVAILABLE

Regular Cart Service—Regular trash service is collected weekly and includes a regular cart. The regular cart holds 4-5 30-gallon trash bags and three additional bags are allowed outside the cart each week at no additional charge.

Bag Tag Service—With this "pay-as-you-throw" program, you only pay for the trash you have. Simply purchase tags for \$2 each from the Village of Saranac offices or Saranac Hardware. Affix one tag to each bag you place out for collection. Cart not included.

Recycling Service (OPTIONAL)—Recycling collection is available every other week for an additional charge. A Curby Recycler cart is included.

Senior Discounted Cart Service Now Available to Saranac Residents

Granger is now offering discounted cart service for senior Saranac residents who produce a small volume of trash.

- · Collected weekly
- Includes a small cart that holds 2-3
 30-gallon trash bags (with no additional bags or items outside the cart)
- Available to households with at least one resident 60 years or older
- Participating households must have three or fewer residents
- Savings of \$1.30 per month

GUIDELINES

COLLECTION TIPS

- Per Village ordinance, trash and recycling carts shall be removed from the front yard no later than 7 p.m. on the day of the scheduled pickup.
- Please bag all trash, even if you are using a cart.
- Double bag loose waste like kitty litter, animal waste, sawdust, ashes, insulation and packing peanuts.
- Place long items like broom handles, curtain rods, etc. on the ground beside the trash.
- Recyclables can be placed loose in the recycling container.

WASTE ACCEPTANCE

In order to ensure we are complying with all state rules and regulations and so our associates can do their jobs safely, please carefully follow our waste acceptance guidelines. They also protect you!

Please do not put the following in your trash:

- Open, empty or used beverage containers (with a deposit)
- Whole car or truck tires (scrap tires)
- Grass clippings or leaves
- Used oil (Oil filters must be drained for 24 hours before being placed in trash.)
- · Car or truck batteries
- Oil-based paint (Latex paint is allowed, but only if dried.)
- Refrigerants/Freon (must be properly removed from appliances prior to disposal)
- · Empty drums (unless clean and crushed)
- · Explosives, ammunition or firearms
- Propane or other compressed gas tanks (unless empty and disabled)
